



Egina Mooring Hookup Project

Ariosh, in collaboration with DOF Subsea conducted the hookup of the mooring lines for the Egina Floating Production Storage Offloading (FPSO) and the Egina Offshore Loading Terminal (OLT). The Egina field is situated offshore Nigeria within the Oil Mining Lease OML-130, some 200km from Port Harcourt, in a water depth ranging from 1150m to 1750m.

The development of the Egina field is based on subsea wells connected to a FPSO facility and stabilized crude oil export via oil tanker using an offloading buoy. Both the OLT and the FPSO are spread-moored, with 3 x 3 leg mooring system and 4 x 4 leg mooring systems respectively.

The scope of work includes:

- a. Recovery and hookup of 9 mooring lines to the OLT
- b. Recovery and hookup of 16 mooring lines to the Egina FPSO.

The Skandi Skansen Anchor Handling Tug (AHT) was used for the mooring hookup. The project scope was completed in Q3 2018.
